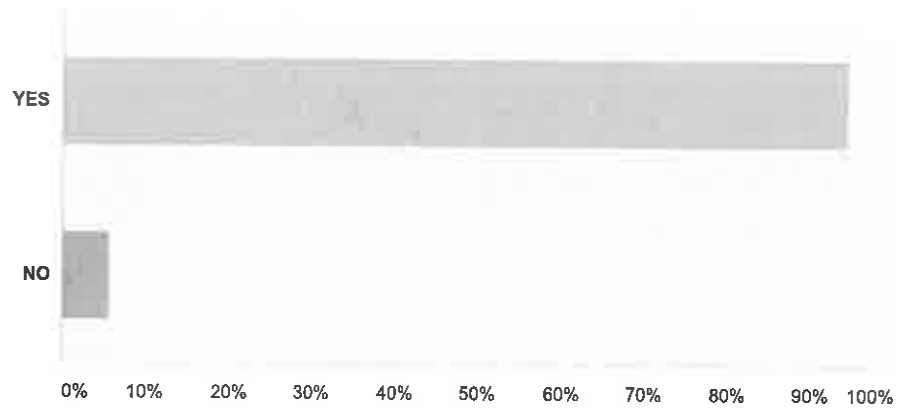


Q1 Do you or have you had children in the District?

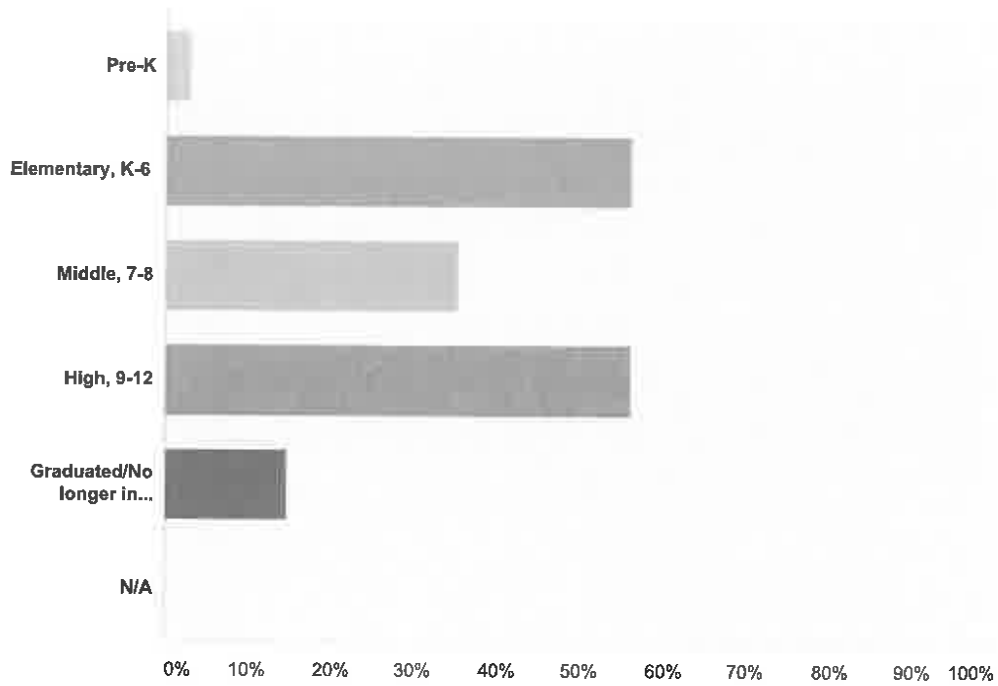

Q2 What current grade level? (Select ALL that apply)

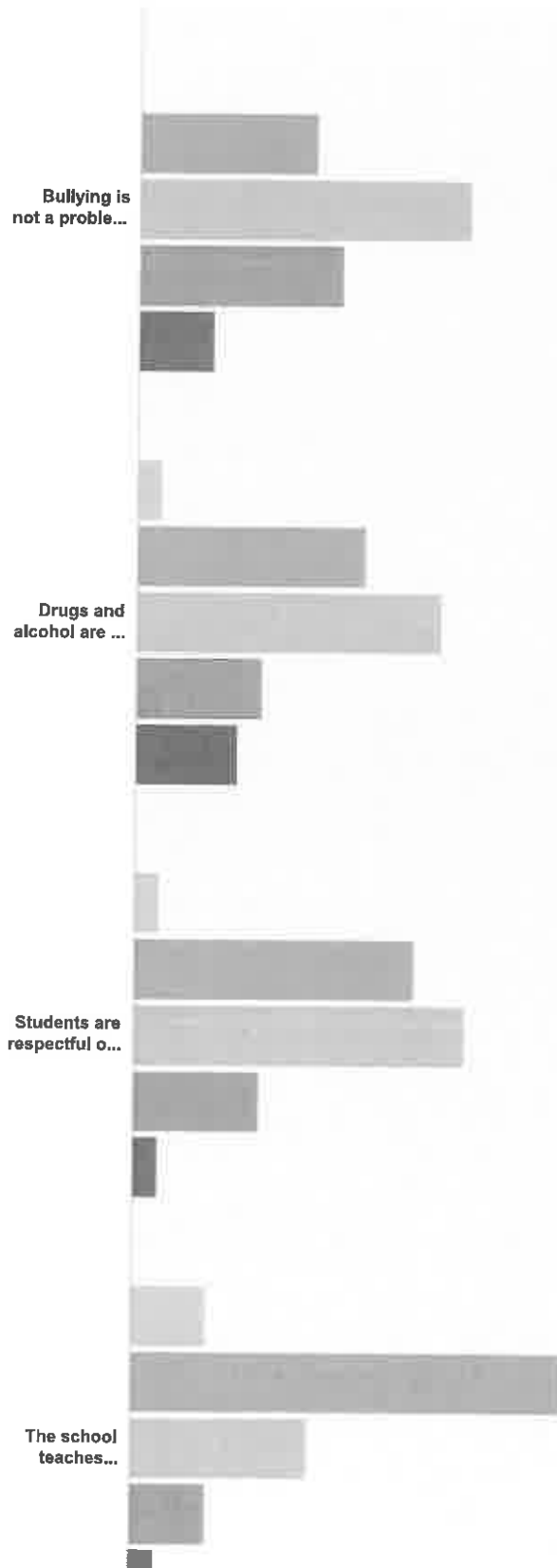

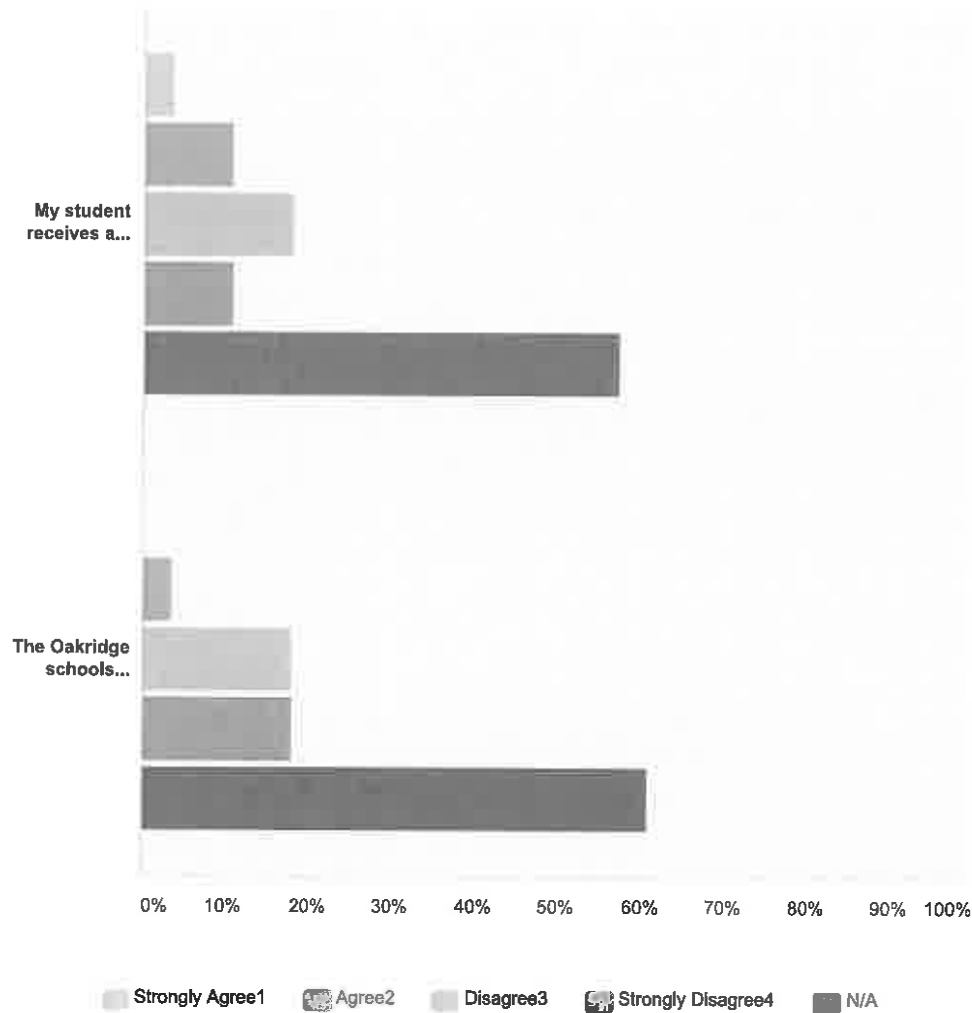
